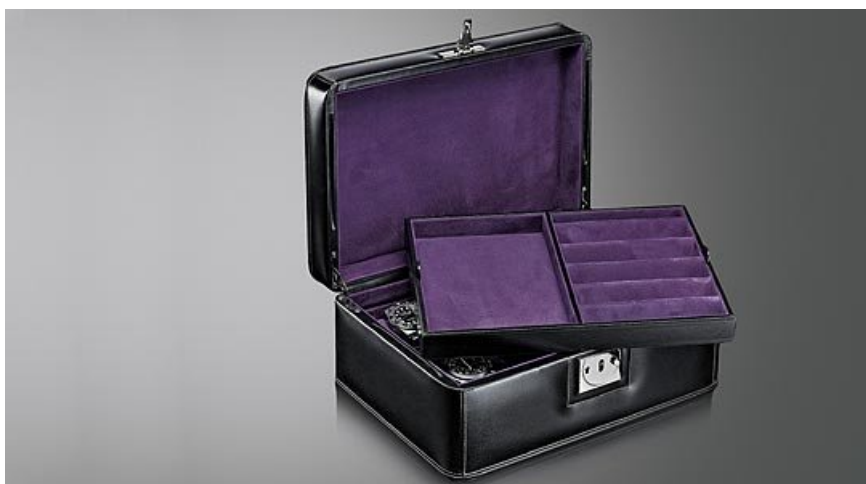

The exterior hide can be one of many sumptuous colours while the interior, which will hold eight watches, and ten pairs of cufflinks in its 'men's tidy', can be supplied in Alcantara or goatskin, again in a selection of hues.

The 13.5 x 32 x 23cm box is made to order and priced from £2995.00.
