
Goodwood - Festival of Speed 2000 - Interviews

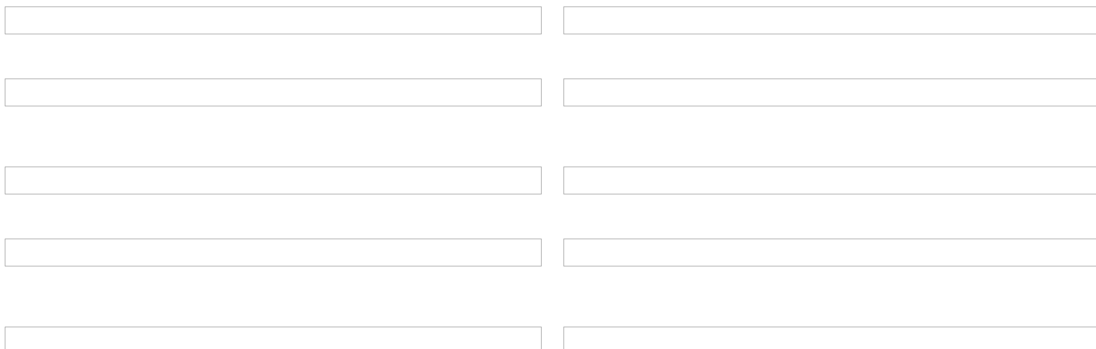
