Ford GT40 of Bellm/Lanzante wins in Spain 2002




Bellm/Lanzante GB/GB - Ford GT 40; 2. Connor/Sullivan - Porsche 911 Carrera 3L;

Despite some serious excursions off route, the GT40, so dominant at the recent Le Mans Classic, was the ultimate victor.
