

- 6 speed manual gearbox with 6th gear giving 40 mph/1000 rpm. (100mph = 2,500 rpm).
- All-independent suspension by coil springs/wishbones. Ventilated disc brakes all round.
- 18" Hallibrand pattern peg-drive wheels, polished rim/white centre; 200 mph Dunlop tyres.
- 1960's style interior layout, fully trimmed in leather, suede and Alcantara etc.
- Rear opening 'hatchback' incorporating tinted rear window. Extensive luggage space.
