Indeed, McNish has an excellent chance of winning again in 2008, in the Audi R10 TDI sports-prototype he will be sharing with Dindo Capello and Tom Kristensen on 14-15 June.

Between them, Mass and McNish have a quarter-century of Le Mans experience. To hear their combined reminiscences and anecdotes (teased out of them by Master of Ceremonies Tony Dron) is certain to be a truly special experience.
