# Monterey and Pebble Beach 2009

Can it be 12 months since I was packing my trunk for Monterey? Yes indeed; a lot's happened in the world since then, but the planet keeps spinning and Monterey week remains one of the automotive high spots of the year.

**Bentley** and **Bugatti** will be the featured marques at the week's finale, the **Pebble Beach Concours d'Elegance** on Sunday 16 August. However, starting with **Doug and Genie Freedman's Carmel-by-the-Sea Concours on the Avenue** on the Tuesday, it's a non-stop week of amazing cars that you are *genuinely* unlikely to see in such concentrations anywhere else in the world.

There's something happening virtually every day and evening, from concours, automobilia exhibitions and tours, to serious racing at **The Rolex Monterey Historic Races at Mazda Laguna Seca Raceway** and the world-famous classic car auctions where tens of millions of dollars will change hands in just a few hours.

And the new-car manufacturers take the event very seriously, too. **Bentley**, for example, will launch its 2010 **'Grand Bentley'** Arnage replacement on the Lawn at Pebble on Sunday.

You can be assured that **Classic Driver** will cover all the big events in the weeks to come, but here's our list of some of the must-do events.

#### THE SCHEDULE -

### Carmel-by-the-Sea Concours on the Avenue

Tuesday 11 August



This is a great event held in the charming, small, seaside town of Carmel. For one day, the picturesque streets become *en fête* with specially decorated shopfronts and line upon line of classic cars ranging from **classic Americana** ('**muscle**' cars, **Cobras** and '**Woodies**') through **Miuras**, **275 GTBs** and their ilk, to quirky oddities such as the micro-cars that were such fun in 2008.

The concours during the day is free, too! While you are in Carmel, you can spend some time looking at the cars, window-shopping at the many antique shops or eating out in one of the many high-quality (and surprisingly reasonable – if you control yourself with the wine list...) restaurants. '**II Fornaio**' is one of the most famous and provides in-house catering for many of the events, while we also liked '**Cantinetta Luca**' on Dolores Street, between Ocean & 7th, Carmel, CA 93921.

**The Rolex Monterey Historic Races at Mazda Laguna Seca Raceway** Friday 14 - Sunday 16 August



The event celebrates its 36th anniversary this year. Over 145 historic Porsches are expected to be racing at the famous, rolling, hillside course.

**Rolex** will present its **'Moments in Time'** display again and this exhibition will include more racing Porsches and the famous pair of cars that, in 1969, provided the **Le Mans 24 Hours'** closest finish: the **Gulf Ford GT40** and the works long-tail **Porsche 908**.
