St Moritz: 17th British Classic Car Meeting



Every July, some 150 British classics make their way to St Moritz for a low-pressure regularity run and concours d'elegance. While the cars are British, the drivers are a multinational mix but there's a heavy predominance of Swiss participants - since the Meeting is an official event of a number of Swiss classic car clubs; namely, those in support of Rolls-Royce, Bentley, Jaguar, Aston Martin and Austin-Healey. But there is still a sprinkling of Brits.

This year's one-day regularity rally starts on **Saturday 10 July** and heads from **St Moritz** out into neighbouring Italy and then back to the **Engadin** - a friendly, rather than highly competitive, run. On Sunday, it's the turn of the concours, and a chance to enjoy the beauty of the automobiles in the glorious surroundings of **St Moritz**, 1800 metres above sea-level on the sunny side of the **Swiss Alps**.
