Team Classic Driver Triumphs at OGP 2010



The Historic Marathon race at the 38th AvD-Oldtimer-Grand-Prix (13-15 August 2010) was won by Team Classic Driver's 1964 Ford Fairlane. The drivers, 'Fred' and 'Barney' from Griesheim, secured victory on the challenging Nürburgring circuit after a thrilling duel with the Jaguar Etype of the Gotcha Historic Racing Team, taking first place at the end of the 3.5-hour race.

These two teams dominated the entire race but it was **Team Classic Driver** that led from the beginning, having taken pole position in the timed practice. Despite the neck-and-neck racing, **'Fred'** and **'Barney'** held onto the lead and took the chequered flag with an average speed of 142km/h – and the fastest lap of the race at 10min 20.672seconds.
