Kavinsky: Drifting back to the Eighties

Sunglasses at night, neon synth soundtrack, a drifting Ferrari Testarossa – and a customary tail from the LAPD: the latest music video from French electro producer Kavinsky shows a wild trip through '80s Los Angeles.

The great American neo-noir classics such as *Blade Runner*, *Terminator*, and *Miami Vice* seem to have inspired Vincent Belorgey – better known by his stage name 'Kavinsky'. But it's not only the era's synthesised compositions that the 1975-born producer has taken a lead from. He chose a car synonymous with the 1980s – a Ferrari Testarossa – to pilot in the video for his latest song 'Protovision'.
