The arrival of the Rolls-Royce Silver Shadow and Bentley T series in late 1965 marked a major

change in Rolls-Royce motor cars; previously the products of Crewe had employed separate chassis but here was a car using unitary construction of chassis and body. This change, brought about by perceived market demands that considered the upright styling of the Silver Cloud / S series rather dated.

At the Silver Shadow's heart was; Rolls-Royce's familiar alloy V8 engine retaining the same 6,230cc as in the Silver Cloud III / S3 and a power output of around 220bhp. It was in the chassis, however, that important changes were made, most notably the adoption of all round independent
