The resultant 350GT, its Scaglione styling considerably refined by Touring of Milan, debuted at the 1964 Geneva Salon and was a huge success, beneath the alloy body lay a V12 engine boasting four camshafts, six Weber carburettors, a ZF five speed gearbox, the finest Girling disc brakes and racing style all round coil spring/double wishbone suspension.
