Towards the end of the 1950s, Standard-Triumph was enjoying great success with its range of two seater Triumph sports cars which were offered alongside a range of Standard saloons. The company started work on the Herald in the 1960s and by 1967 the range was updated with the introduction of the Herald 13/60 with a restyled front end using the bonnet of the Triumph Vitesse, but with single rather than twin headlights, to give a sleeker, more modern appearance, while the interior

substantially revised, though still featuring the traditional wooden dashboard.

Under the bonnet, engine capacity was increased to 1,296cc and with 61bhp performance was much improved. Total Herald sales numbered well over 300,000, thanks in no small part to the number of variants made possible by its separate chassis des
