The metal is drawn from the pistons of donor cars such as a <u>DB2/4 Mk II</u>, a <u>DB5</u> and an <u>X-Pack V8 Vantage</u>; other subtle features tailored to reflect the relevant decade will distinguish each version, as will different paint and trim colours from the Q personalisation division.
