## A case of small man syndrome



The children will be interested in certain lots from Arturial's automobilia auction, in particular the several junior cars on offer. Our highlight is the <u>'Ferrarina' 312 T2</u>, a downsized version of Niki Lauda's 1976 F1 car carrying an estimate of €15,000 – 25,000. Elsewhere in the catalogue, a pint-sized counterpart to the headlining ex-Alain Delon Ferrari California Spider is expected to fetch €12,000 – 18,000; the ideal steed for a 'Classic Driver in training', perhaps?

More seasoned style sages might be tempted by the range of vintage picnic cases offered at the Bonhams auction nearby. The highlight is a six-person case made in Paris around 1905, estimated to command €30,000 – 40,000. Or perhaps your tastes are better suited to a cutaway model of a Renault Dauphine, which the manufacturer used for presentation purposes in period?
