Revealed at the 1972 Geneva Motor Show and built on Bora underpinnings, the <u>Boomerang</u> was designed by Giorgetto Giugiaro (then at Italdesign), who said the car was drawn "almost entirely with a ruler". What's more, the Boomerang was among the first angular design studies, of which many more – bolstered by their popularity – would follow throughout the decade. Perhaps unsurprisingly, the pre-sale estimate is available on request only. If you're keen on ultra-rare coupés, the one-of-a-handful Aigle-bodied Alfa Romeo 1900C Super Sprint is also offered at the sale. And on this week's topic of <u>ultra-low-mileage classics</u>, how about a Lancia Aurelia B52 with just 3,700km from new?
