Alpine's mid-engined sports car edges closer to production

Over the weekend, Alpine celebrated its 60th anniversary at Le Mans by revealing the Celebration sports car, a mid-engined two-seater that takes styling cues from its predecessors...

Holster those party poppers, though – the Celebration is billed as a 'show car' rather than a production model, although it's clearly a lot closer to reality than the (more dramatic) <u>A110-50 concept of 2012</u>. Specific details on the new car are yet to be released, but we expect a turbocharged four- or six-cylinder engine powering the rear wheels, with gunsights trained on the likes of the <u>Alfa Romeo 4C</u>, <u>Lotus Elise</u> and, to an extent, the <u>Porsche Cayman</u>.
