Unbelievably, this beautiful example is still owned by the man who bought it new in California in 1955, having covered around 135,000 miles since. Along the way, the Black Prince gained some unusual modifications, such as the deep pearl-black paintwork (much better and more durable than the factory paint) with gold pinstripe detailing, only adding to its unique appeal. Bonhams has estimated that the bike will fetch 90,000-110,000 US dollars.
