In addition to a small number of other classic rally icons, the Group B contingent was listed by Classic Driver Dealer [Top Marques](#), and comprises an [ex-Works Martini Racing Lancia Delta S4](#) and a [Belga-liveried Ford RS200](#), both from 1986. The former was used as a spare car for Miki Biasion at the Rally of Argentina, while the latter – set up for Tarmac – was one of two cars driven by Robert Droogmans for the 1986 season. Other cars in the feverish inventory include the [Martini Racing Lancia Delta Evoluzione](#) in which Didier Auriol and Bernard Occelli won the 1992 Rally Costa Smeralda, and a [1970 Lancia Fulvia HF1600 'Fanalone' Group 4](#) purchased new from the Works racing department. Who cares about panel gaps? We're shaken, stirred, and completely smitten.
