A new exhibition at the Museo Enzo Ferrari – situated in the grounds of Il Commendatore's former house in Modena – pays tribute to the marque's role on the silver screen, with a number of A-listers on display...



The silver screen stars on display include the *Magnum P.I.* 308 GTSs, the *Miami Vice* Testarossa, the 512S used in *Le Mans* and the 375 America driven by the equally gorgeous Sophia Loren in *Boy on a Dolphin*. Beyond icons with their own on-screen provenance, other exhibits represent the objects of affection for such names as Paul Newman, Steve McQueen, Peter Sellers and Marilyn Monroe – the latter of which held the white 250 GT Cabriolet Pininfarina above in particularly high regard.
