We previewed the Frist Center's forthcoming 'Bellissima!' exhibition <u>as early as last year</u>, when it was first revealed that 22 cars and motorcycles would be gathered in the Tennessee museum to celebrate the post-War Italian automotive renaissance. Among the exhibits will be icons such as the Ferrari 250 GTO and Lamborghini Miura, oddities such at the Chrysler Ghia Gilda and Lancia Stratos Zero concepts, and rarities such as a Cisitalia 202 SC and an Alfa Romeo 6C 2500 S by Pinin Farina – the latter a previous prize-winner at Villa d'Este. With the exhibition opening next week, Rizzoli has now revealed an accompanying book co-authored by the curator Ken Gross, also the former director of the Petersen Automotive Museum.
