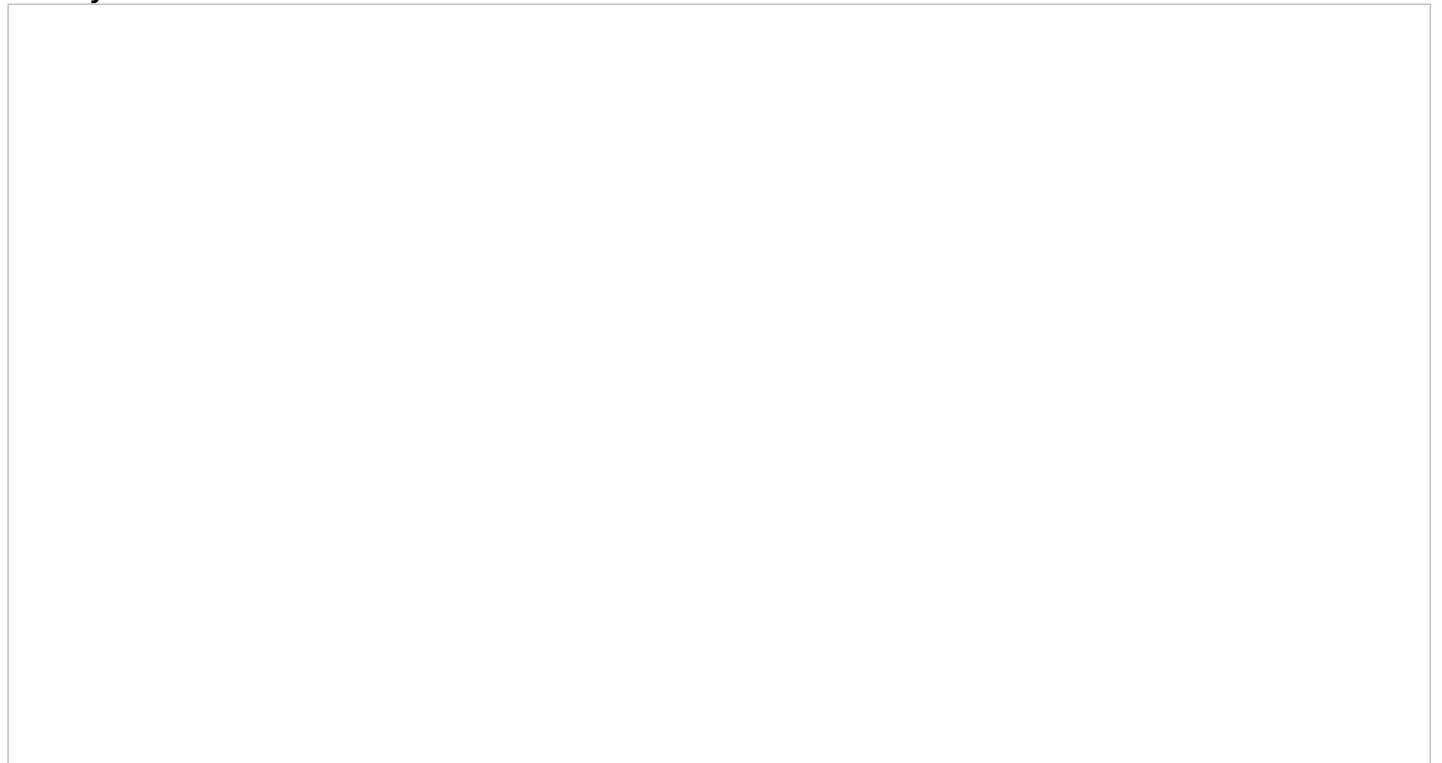
Amid its stark financial woes, MV Agusta has set the rumour mill alight by teasing a new concept designed by the legendary Milanese design house Zagato...
