Why do the majority of modern sports car plummet in value the moment they turn a wheel, while a select few soar into the market's stratosphere? It's largely a prestigious badge, a raw driving experience and severely limited quantities that arouse desire - and commensurately drive prices up...

Manufacturers have now recognised this and generate plenty of hype around special limited-production models, whose benefits are multi-fold. For a start, they enjoy higher margins and can 'reward' loyal customers with a production slot, while using the resulting 'halo effect' to sell lesser models - recent examples include the [Porsche 911R](#), the [Aston Martin Vantage GT12](#), and the new [Ferrari anniversary models](#). If you're not yet at the point where manufacturers are *contacting you* to offer a prized slot, you'll need to pay a premium to join the limited-production party by proxy - but your investment should prove to be a safe one long-term, as these are the Miura SVs or Alloy-bodied Gullwings of the future.
