Other lots that caught our eye include the wide-bodied <u>1983 Renault 5 Turbo</u> with just 5,900 kilometres from new (75,000-95,000 euros), the beautifully restored <u>1973 Alfa Romeo Montreal</u> (80,000-100,000 euros), and the gorgeously weathered <u>1952 'Split Window' Volkswagen Beetle</u> (55,000-80,000 euros).
