After 17 attempts to bring historic racing back to Auerberg, the weekend of 16 September finally saw the flag drop at the inaugural Auerberg Klassik, with hundreds of drivers and thousands of spectators in attendance. Rare two-wheeled machinery from 1925 to 1979 tackled the three-kilometre stretch in fine style, with classic car and motorbikes gathering to witness.
