Limited to 176 numbered pieces, the 44mm watch is forged from titanium and its automatic movement boasts a power reserve of 46 hours. In a subtle nod to the Members' Meeting, the movement's protective 'cage' is detailed to look like a brake disc and is emblazoned with the number 76, which is visible through the exhibition case back.
