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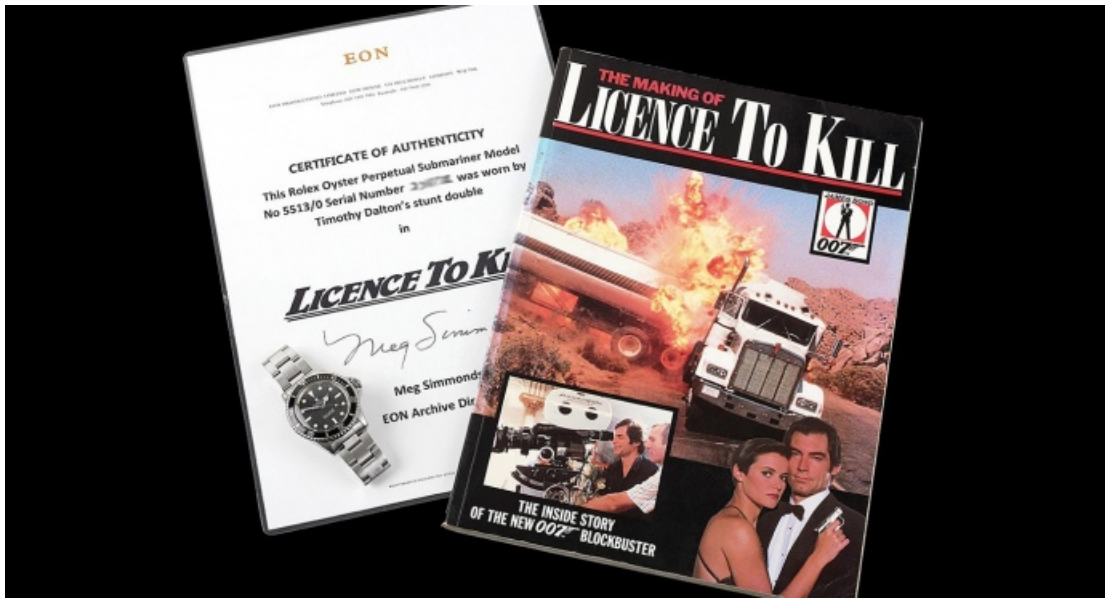
This Rolex Submariner may or may not grant you A Licence to Kill

Timothy Dalton's stunt double wore this very Rolex Submariner during the British actor's final appearance as 007 in A Licence to Kill. It's a reference 5513 with its original matching Oyster bracelet and for those with a little imagination, its knocks and scratches may well have been sustained in the line of duty.
