In honour of NASA's 60th anniversary, Hong Kong watch brand Anicorn has released a minimalist wristwatch, limited to just 60 pieces, that is easy to read both on Earth and whilst suspended in weightlessness. The numbered, white, ceramic-coated watches will be shipped with matching cloth wristbands and commemorative plaques inscribed with the GPS coordinates of the Kennedy Space Center in Florida — just in case you lose your bearings on your return from Mars.

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
