It's a special edition version of the Seamaster Diver 300M Co-Axial Master Chronometer featuring a matte black dial and bezel with aged lume markings and a very pretty titanium mesh bracelet. It's a watch that while not as elegant as the Seamaster 300 Bond wore in 2015's Spectre is a bit beefier and in line with the gritty character of the Craig-era films. The Seamaster Diver 300M 007 Edition will cost 8,100 US dollars on a NATO strap and 9,200 dollars on the bracelet.
