Lead The iconic white and blue American racing livery dates right back to the 1950s. These three monstrous Fords are a tempting homage to period sports car racing and up for auction with RM Sotheby's this November 12th.

In the 1950s, rules stipulated that race teams use colours which represented their countries: Italian cars were red, British green, Belgians yellow, French blue, Germans silver. American entries were painted white with blue accents. Briggs Cunningham's cars ran two thick blue stripes over his race cars, the livery often referred to as the "Cunningham stripes". A young Peter Brock was a fan of Cunningham's cars and by the time he found himself working for Shelby in the Mid-60s he adapted the scheme for the Shelby Fords. This November you can bid on a 2005 Ford GT, 2014 Shelby GT500 Super Snake Prototype and a 2017 GT350R, all three adorned with the iconic colour combination. For us it has to be the 2005 Ford GT that marked a return to form for the legendary brand. Which one would you choose?
